It's been a great month at Cornerstone. The friendly team at Street Side Medics have settled in at Cornerstone beautifully, and provide such valuable medical support for our community.

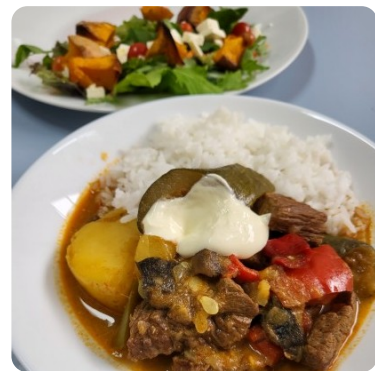
